

Principal's Note

I have had some questions from our students regarding the town's votes to withdraw from the merger. They wondered if our schools are closing, they wondered if staff will be coming back. They wondered what it means for them. Wednesday, a substitute was asked if she was going to be the new principal. Sometimes we think our children are not aware of what is going on, however they are listening, hearing, and



trying to make sense of what is happening around them. I let my Readsboro students know that any decision about the merger would now be taking place at the State level. I let them know that the voting outcome wasn't about someone being right or wrong. I reassured them that the staff was staying put and that we had quite a bit to do before the end of our school year. I let them know that the school board representatives have stated on numerous occasions how important their local schools are.

I want our parents to know that the staff at both schools are committed to our students and their success. The staff continues to focus their energy on providing instruction and ongoing learning opportunities ensuring that our students continue to develop their skills and abilities. As we continue through this process I will answer student questions as best I can. Right now, as community members, we wait to hear about the next steps, but that doesn't mean our work at school waits; our focus is and will be on learning.

Opportunities for Engagement with the SVUUSD-Readsboro Principal Hiring Process:

The Southern Valley School District has an opening for its Readsboro Campus School Principal for the 2020-2021 school year. We are beginning the search process to identify a talented principal who will lead the Readsboro community. We recognize the importance of the Principal as the key person who will lead our school forward and invite you to get involved in the process.

Interview Advisory Committee: The interview advisory committee will be comprised of representatives from various roles within the District. The committee will likely include 1-2 teachers/staff, 1-2 parent/community members, 3 board members and 2 administrators. The committee will review application materials, conduct interviews with qualified candidates, and will select some to move onto the second interview stage before presenting a final list of candidates for consideration by the Superintendent. The commitment to the committee will be around 15 hours, taking place in the day and evening, at times agreeable for the majority of participants. We kindly ask that committee members commit to the entire process.
