

PURPOSE OF A LOCAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

- Comprehensive town vulnerability to natural hazard assessment
- Opportunity for the town to develop mitigation projects
- Projects in Plans have more chance of getting \$ from FEMA
 through mitigation grants
- Vermont Emergency Relief Assistance Fund (ERAF) incentive for
 State match after a federal declaration



WHAT KINDS OF HAZARDS ARE WE TALKING ABOUT?

- Focusing on Natural Hazards
 - Defined as: Source of harm or difficulty created by a meteorological, environmental, or geological event
 - Examples: Fluvial Erosion and Flooding were covered in current plan







WHAT IS MITIGATION?

- Mitigation is any sustained action taken to eliminate or reduce future risk to people and property from disasters.
 - Mitigation saves time and money by decreasing real-world damages.
 - Mitigation can take place anytime, but the intent is always to reduce risk from future hazards.


