Re; Closed Halifax Landfill - Spring 2025 Water Quality Monitoring Report

Dear Edee,

Thank you for the submittal of the May 2025 water quality report. The report was received by the Solid Waste Management Program (SWMP) on June 18, 2025, and is found to be in compliance with Conditions 6 and 11 of the solid waste certification, dated July 11, 2017, as amended by the reduction of monitoring in March 2024.

Thank you for the sampling of the Branch Brook. Since the results came back non-detected for PFAS, the one-time sampling event has satisfied the SWMP's request. PFAS exceeds the Vermont Groundwater Enforcement Standard (VGES) of 20 ppt (parts per trillion) in MW-3 and has overall mixed trends recorded at 142 ppt during this sampling event, down from its highest detection of 286 ppt in May 2024.
